### **Membership Report**

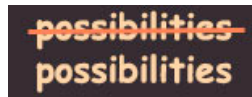
Membership dues were collected. Extra copies of the 2006 JSTAE were sold to those who had not seen the 2006 journal.

### **Officer Positions**

Clayton Funk was voted in as incoming Coordinator Elect. Kryssi Staikidis was designated as incoming Recorder. Jim Sanders was thanked as outgoing Coordinator, as was Olivia Gude as outgoing Recorder. Wanda B. Knight will be CSTAE editor for volume 28 (2007-2008).

### **Social Theory in Art Education Journal**

Wanda B. Knight announced that she and her fellow editor William Wightman expect that the journal will be published during summer 2007. Articles are still being revised by authors. Wanda thanked the editors and authors for their work on the journal. The theme of the soon-to-be published 2007 journal is:



After considering several options, and at the third CSTAE meeting, *Introduction to Writing for JSTAE*, those attending decided by consensus that the theme of the 2008 issue of the *Journal of Social Theory in Art Education* will be *OTHER(W)ise*.

Recent volumes of the *Journal of Social Theory in Art Education* (JSTAE) are accessible as full-text pdf files on the ProQuest database, which is subscribed to by many university libraries, making JSTAE internationally available. Searches can be conducted by author name, journal title, subject, article title, and key terms. Making *JSTAE* more available will make it more advantageous for authors to publish in the journal because of wider distribution and issues related to work being valued for tenure purposes.

## JSTAE Book

NAEA has accepted the book proposal for: *InCITE/InSIGHT/InSITE: 25 Years of The Journal of Social Theory in Art Education*, exploring the significance of social theory in understanding important issues in the field of art education. The text is co-authored by Karen Keifer-Boyd, Mike Emme, and Jan Jagodzinski with contributions of 12 reprinted articles by prior *Journal of Social Theory in Art Education* (JSTAE) authors. The book will include a searchable CD-ROM with hyperlinked index, containing all articles of 25 years of JSTAE. Karen Keifer-Boyd announced that help with editing of the reprinted articles by looking up page numbers to cited work that is incomplete would be appreciated. Credit to all who help will be given. She urged members to help with editing 12 articles before April 17, 2007. Help with articles on the CD will take place between 4/17/07 and July 2007. NAEA may still reject the idea of the CD. If NAEA doesn't agree, the CSTAE may produce the CD on our own.

CSTAE funds are currently low. Coordinator will send out a fundraising letter request. It was suggested that 10 people who each contributed 50 dollars might be a great way to accumulate funds.
